3. Families who prefer pick-up and drop-off should discuss with PHASE to organise.
4. Families can nominate their preferred Carer(s). Carers will, however, be required to be on the employ of PHASE and meet their strict employment selection and recruitment process.
5. Cancellation requests **MUST** be lodged in with the program coordinator 24-hrs prior. A minimum of 4 hours shall apply for cases lodged in less than 24hrs prior program commencement date. Unless compelling reasons exist for cancellation on the day of program commencement, PHASE may refuse refund requests and full fees shall apply. All cancellation shall be notified by email and text message and treated as **URGENT**.
6. Individuals can vary their attendance in the case of sickness and cancellation. Strict conditions apply.
